

Programme structure

This programme is offered on a full time basis and students are required to complete six modules from a list of prescribed modules and a research project.

Programme duration

The programme is offered over a duration of one year and lectures are held during the day.

Programme modules

Eligibility

Applicants must be in possession of a Bachelor's Degree in Management, with a minimum average of 55% on the following level three Management modules: Corporate Strategy, Business Ethics, Technology Management and International Business. Meeting these requirements does not guarantee acceptance into the programme as places are limited.
